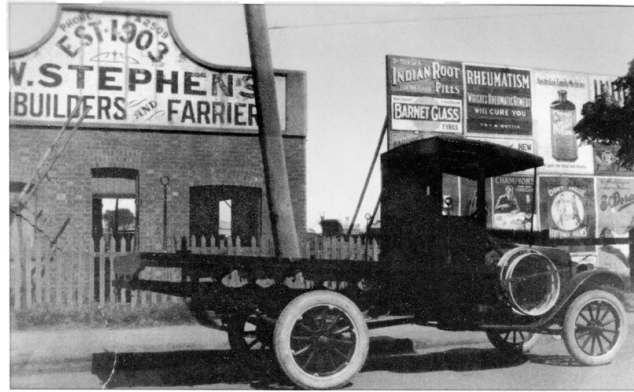

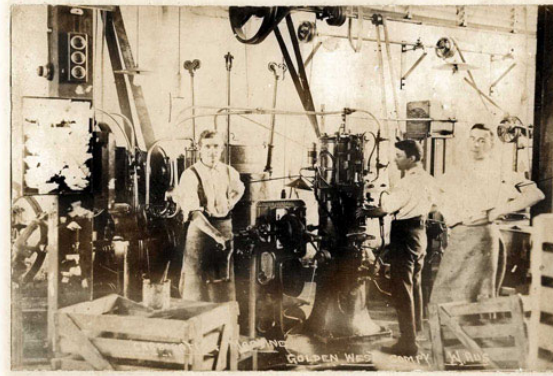


Hyde Park 1923 with a single lake.

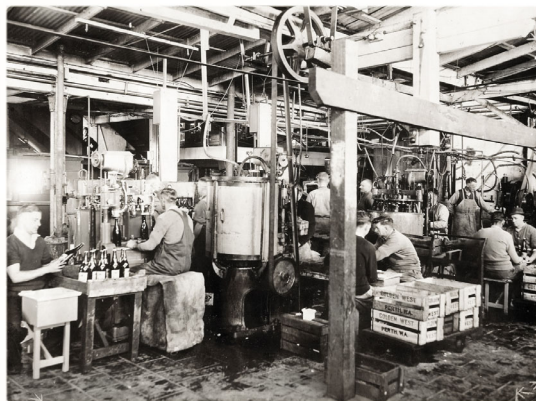

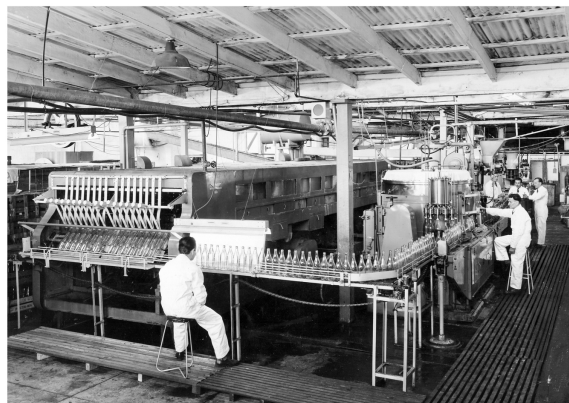

Union Football Team Premiers 1903.
